Kind of Old News:

Jen Ken introduces JK² kiln – *Unveiled at the GlassCraft Expo this past April, this kiln is 27" side to side with 45 degree corners. Inside height is either 11" or 15".*

Jen Ken introduces Take-Apart Bead Annealer – *Also unveiled at GlassCraft Expo, this is an 11" hexagonal kiln with a 3 key digital controller. The bottom, top and sides are three separate pieces. Inside height is 4 ½ inches until you add a collar with a 2" flip-up bead door that makes it 9 inches tall inside. It is not on our website yet, but call for details.*

Paragon introduces Blue Bird Bead Annealer - *This toolbox style kiln heats to 1200 degrees and features two 10" by 2 ¾" bead doors.*

Paragon upgrades the Sentry Express 3.0 digital controller to version 4.0. *See the manual on our website.*
