Beginning Pate de Verre and Glass Casting using the Higuchi techniques taught at the Corning Studio. Students will learn all techniques necessary to make single-part molds.

Sally Eyring is an accomplished glass artist in Boston who studied pate de verre under world-famous masters Kimiake and Shinichi Higuchi at Corning. She has further studied with Helen Stokes at Corning and Alicia Lomne and Sylvia Levinson at Bullseye. She is well known throughout New England for her exquisite work and tireless involvement in the International Guild of Glass Artists.
